Statement of The International Council Supporting Fair Trial and Human Rights – Geneva,

On bombing incident in the Deyah village of Bahrain

The International Council Supporting Fair Trial And Human Rights (ICSFT) denounces, the terrorist bombing that occurred recently in the Deyah village on Monday, March 3, 2014 and resulted in the deaths of three policemen and wounding others during performing their duty, and the council expresses its condolences to the families of the victims and refuses incitement to violence in all its forms.

The Council stresses that this work violates all heavenly religions and is criminalized by laws and can not be linked to the peaceful activists during demonstrating peacefully to get their legitimate demands, and that this bombing does not serve efforts for the success of the dialogue and even hinders its continuation.

The ICSFT calls for the Human Rights Council of the United Nations to form a neutral international commission of inquiry to investigate the circumstances of the incident and raise its transparent and neutral report to the Human Rights Council to take the appropriate actions .
